Policy Guidelines for Waste Segregation at Source

VILLAGE

1. THE ROLE OF OWNERS/RESIDENTS

- The owners/residents need to make sure waste is segregated according to categories namely recyclable waste and non-recyclable waste.
- Send the recyclable waste to collection centre.

2. THE ROLE OF IMPLEMENTER

- To establish recycling sub-committee (JKKK).
- To identify, manage and maintain the recycling centre.
- To ensure recyclable waste is collected and managed appropriately as scheduled.
- To appoint an individual to segregate recyclable waste at the collection centre according to the category.
- To appoint licensed recycling agents as stated under Subsidiary Legislation of Waste Segregation and Licensing of Recyclable Waste Collection Service (MBPP/MPSP) 2016, to collect recyclable waste.

3. IMPLEMENTATION METHOD

- Owners or residents send the recyclable waste to collection centre or
- Recycling sub-committee or the implementer by himself collect the recyclable waste from the premise.
