Policy Guidelines for Waste Segregation at Source

RESIDENTIAL AREA

1. THE ROLE OF OWNERS/RESIDENTS

- The owners/residents have to make sure waste is segregated according to categories namely recyclable waste and non-recyclable waste.
- Recyclable waste should be put/packed in suitable containers as fixed by Council and placed outside of the house for collection (Saturday); or
- **©** Send recyclable waste to collection centre.

2. METHODS OF IMPLEMENTATION

a) House to House Collection by the Council

- Collection system involving Council collecting from house to house.
- Collection will be done every Saturday.
- Records regarding recyclable waste management should be kept by the Council.

b) Collection Centre (if needed)

- Collection centre is a method that enable the owners/residents to put recyclable waste at a nearby collection centre.
- The owners/residents have to segregate recyclable waste from non-recyclable waste and put recyclable waste at the collection centre.
- Licensed collector of recyclable waste will collect the waste only from the collection centre.
- Records regarding recyclable waste management should be kept by the licensed collector of recyclable waste.
